Four stations, each with five customized Zimmer Biomet bicycles, will be provided by Zagster, a leading U.S. bike share organization that allows individuals to rent bicycles via a mobile application. The

stations will be located in downtown Warsaw, Boggs Industrial Park, The Village at Winona Lake and on the Grace College campus.
